

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

(Promulgated 8th October, 1937.)

PROCLAMATION

Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Special Court
Amendment Proclamation, 1937.

Whereas it is expedient further to amend the Bechuanaland Protectorate Special Court Proclamation 1912 (No. 40 of 1912).

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Sub-section (1) of section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Special Court Proclamation 1912 as amended shall be and is hereby repealed and the following new sub-section substituted therefor:—

“1. (1) There shall be and is hereby established for the Bechuanaland Protectorate a Court to be called ‘the Special Court of the Bechuanaland Protectorate’ which shall be held at such time and such place or places as the Resident Commissioner shall publicly notify, and shall consist of a President who shall be appointed by the High Commissioner, and any two Assistant Commissioners or Resident Magistrates, or Acting Resident Magistrates, nominated in writing by the Resident Commissioner.”

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Special Court Amendment Proclamation 1937, and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
