PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the High Commissioner.

Further amending the Immigration Regulation (Bechuanaland Protectorate) Proclamation, 1932.

Whereas it is expedient to amend further the Immigration Regulation (Bechuanaland Protectorate) Proclamation 1932 (No. 34 of 1932) as amended (hereinafter styled the principal law).

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. The principal law shall be and is hereby amended by the addition of the following new section, to be read as one with the principal law and numbered 16A:—

“16A. The High Commissioner may appoint immigration officers who shall have such powers and perform such duties as may be prescribed in this Proclamation or any regulation made thereunder.”

2. This Proclamation shall be deemed to have been in force and have taken effect as from the 19th August, 1932.
