RESIDENT COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE.

It is hereby notified for general information that in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section *six* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Native Schools Proclamation, 1938 (No. 26 of 1938), the Resident Commissioner has amended the rules for Native Schools published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 110 of 1938 (hereinafter called "the principal rules") as follows:—

1. Rules 3, 6, and 9 of the principal rules are amended by substituting the word "should" for the word "shall" wherever it appears in the said rules.

2. Rule 23 of the principal rules is amended by the addition at the end thereof of the following proviso:—

"Provided that School Committees shall be competent, by arrangement with the Director of Education, to draw up contracts which will permit of termination by three months' notice on either side."
