CUSTOMS.

DUMPING DUTY ON COAL-BURNING STOVES.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers in him vested by section *fifteen* of the Customs Tariff and Excise Duties Amendment Proclamation, No. 20 of 1925, as amended, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to declare that from and after the thirtieth day of September, 1938, there shall be charged, levied, collected and paid on coal-burning stoves of the Dover type, sizes 6, 7 and 8, on importation into the Bechuanaland Protectorate from the United Kingdom, an "ordinary" dumping duty equal to the difference between the "export price" as defined in section *nineteen* of the Customs Tariff and Excise Duties Amendment Proclamation, 1925, as amended, and the "domestic value" thereof as defined in that section, plus the extra cost of packing and packages for export, carriage to port of shipment and all other expenses incidental to placing such stoves on board ship ready for export to the Bechuanaland Protectorate, provided—

- (a) that such difference is greater than five per centum of the export price, and
- (b) that such duty shall not exceed one-half of the value for duty purposes, of the stoves referred to above, as defined in section *fourteen* of the Customs Tariff and Excise Duties Amendment Proclamation, 1925, as amended, and
- (c) that such dumping duty shall not be imposed in respect of such stoves shipped to the Bechuanaland Protectorate from the United Kingdom prior to the above-mentioned date.
