

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No. 23 OF 1938.

In view of the issue of a new series of combined postage and revenue stamps for the Bechuanaland Protectorate on the 12th December, 1932, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased, in terms of section *one* of Proclamation No. 55 of 1933, to make the following regulations providing for the demonetisation of all denominations of the old series of overprinted "Bechuanaland Protectorate" British *postage* stamps:—

- (a) All overprinted postage stamps of each denomination of the old series shall be demonetised with effect from the date of publication of this notice;
- (b) for a period of three months from the date of demonetisation stamps of the old series will be valid for postal purposes, but after that period postal matter bearing such stamps will be subject to surcharge.
