

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No. 48 of 1938.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers in him vested by section *two* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Diseases of Stock Proclamation, 1926, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to make the following further amendment to the Regulations published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 28 of 1926:—

Regulation 18 is hereby amended by inserting, after the word "disease", the following words:—

"and for that purpose or for the purpose of inspection may order any stock to be collected at a specified place and time subject to at least forty-eight hours' notice in writing to that effect".
