

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No. 79 OF 1938.

It is hereby notified for general information that, in terms of section *three* of the High Commissioner's Proclamation, No. 1 of 1903, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to cancel the definitions of the N'gamiland and Chobe Districts respectively (High Commissioner's Notice No. 119 of 1923 as amended by Notice No. 126 of 1930) and to substitute therefor the following:—

N'GAMILAND AND CHOBE DISTRICT.

The Batawana Reserve as defined by section *two* of Proclamation No. 9 of 1899 together with the area of Crown land lying south of the Chobe River, bounded on the west by the boundary of the Batawana Reserve to the point of its intersection with the parallel of latitude 20° South, on the south by a line following the said parallel of latitude to its point of intersection with the meridian of longitude 25° East, thence in a northerly direction along the said meridian of longitude to its point of intersection with the parallel of latitude 19° South, thence in an easterly direction along the said parallel of latitude to its point of intersection with the western border of Southern Rhodesia, and on the East by Southern Rhodesia.
