## PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER.

Entitled the Motor Car (Bechuanaland Protectorate)  
Amendment Proclamation, 1938.

Whereas it is desirable further to amend the Motor Car (Bechuanaland Protectorate) Proclamation, 1929 (No. 10 of 1929) as amended, hereinafter referred to as "the principal law".

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *two* of the principal law is hereby amended by the insertion, immediately after sub-section (7), of the following new sub-section:—

"(8) Notwithstanding anything in this section contained, no licence fee shall be payable in respect of any motor car belonging to the Bechuanaland Protectorate Government."

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the Motor Car (Bechuanaland Protectorate) Amendment Proclamation, 1938, and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
