PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER

Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Public Service
Amendment Proclamation, 1938.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the law governing appointments to and promotions in the Public Service of the Bechuanaland Protectorate (hereinafter referred to as "the Territory").

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *three* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Public Service Proclamation, No. 32 of 1924 (hereinafter referred to as "the said Proclamation") shall be and is hereby repealed and the following section substituted:—

Amendment of section 3 of Proclamation No. 32 of 1924.

" 3. Except in the case of an officer already holding a pensionable office in the Territory or transferred with pension rights from other public service no person shall be appointed to a pensionable office until he shall have served for a period of at least two years on probation, provided that in exceptional cases, with the approval of the High Commissioner, that period may be extended or shortened".

2. Section *eight* of the said Proclamation together with the Schedule set out thereunder shall be and is hereby repealed.

Repeal of section 8 and Schedule to Proclamation No. 32 of 1924.

3. This Proclamation may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Public Service Amendment Proclamation, 1938, and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.

Short title and commencement.
