PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency The High Commissioner

Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Native Labourers (Protection) Amendment Proclamation, 1938.

Whereas it is deemed expedient to amend the Bechuanaland Protectorate Native Labourers (Protection) Proclamation, 1936 (No. 14 of 1936), hereinafter referred to as "the principal law";

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested, I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *eight* of the principal law is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following sentence:—

“The Native Tribunals constituted under the provisions of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Native Tribunals Proclamation, 1934, shall have and may exercise jurisdiction in all cases under this section.”

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Native Labourers (Protection) Amendment Proclamation, 1938, and shall have force and take effect from the first day of July, 1938.
