PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER
Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Stamp Duties
(Amendment) Proclamation, 1938.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Bechuanaland Protectorate Stamp Duties Amendment Proclamation, 1922 (No. 19 of 1922), hereinafter referred to as "the said Proclamation", so as to exempt from stamp duty receipts given by persons employed by local authorities and native administrations for salaries or wages paid to them in respect of such employment:

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Sub-section (1) of section *one* of the said Proclamation is hereby amended by inserting after the words "Government employee" the words "or person employed by a local authority or native administration".

3. This Proclamation may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Stamp Duties (Amendment) Proclamation, 1938, and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
