PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the High Commissioner

Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Aliens (Amendment) Proclamation, 1938.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Aliens Proclamation (Bechuanaland Protectorate), 1937 (No. 48 of 1937), hereinafter referred to as "the said Proclamation":

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested, I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *two* of the said Proclamation is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following sub-section, the present section becoming sub-section (1):—

"(2) Subject to the provisions of section *twelve*, any alien who is found in the Territory and who is not in possession of a permit issued in terms of section *four* or of a temporary permit issued in terms of section *five* or has not been permitted to enter under section *seven* shall be guilty of an offence and may be dealt with under the principal law as a prohibited immigrant."

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Aliens (Amendment) Proclamation, 1938, and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
