

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

RESIDENT COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE.

It is hereby notified for general information that under the provisions of regulation 4 of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Defence (Finance) Regulations, 1939, published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 235 of 1939, the Resident Commissioner has granted the following exemptions:—

- (a) Exemption is granted from the obligation to obtain the permission of the Resident Commissioner to take or send out of the Territory any bank notes to the Union of South Africa, the Mandated Territory of South West Africa, Southern Rhodesia, Basutoland and Swaziland;
- (b) Exemption is granted from the obligation to obtain the permission of the Resident Commissioner to draw or negotiate any bill of exchange or promissory note, transfer any security or acknowledge any debt, so that a right (whether actual or contingent) to receive a payment in the Territory is created or transferred as consideration—
  - (i) for receiving a payment or acquiring property in the Union of South Africa, the Mandated Territory of South West Africa, Southern Rhodesia, Basutoland or Swaziland, or
  - (ii) for a right (whether actual or contingent) to receive a payment or acquire property in the Union of South Africa, the Mandated Territory of South West Africa, Southern Rhodesia, Basutoland or Swaziland,

or to make any payment as such consideration.
