CUSTOMS.

ADDITIONAL DUTY ON VEGETABLE OILS.

It is hereby notified for general information that by section *three* of the Customs Tariff and Excise Duties Amendment Proclamation, 1925, as amended, the High Commissioner may, by Notice in the *Gazette*, bring into operation any duty referred to as suspended duty in the First Schedule to that Proclamation, and that the High Commissioner has been pleased to declare that there shall be charged, levied, collected and paid, with effect from the eleventh day of July, 1939, a suspended duty at the rate of *one penny* per pound weight, as set forth in item 202 (1) of the First Schedule to the Customs Tariff and Excise Duties Amendment Proclamation, 1925, as amended, on palm and palm kernel oils when imported into the Territory or taken out of bond.
