

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE

No. 146 of 1939.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *three* of the Official Secrets (Bechuanaland Protectorate) Proclamation, 1914 (No. 20 of 1914), as amended, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to declare that, until further notice, the under-mentioned places in the Bechuanaland Protectorate are prohibited places:—

- (a) Such areas as are utilised for the purposes of wireless transmitting stations at Maun, Ghanzi, Tsabon, Kazungula, Francistown and Nata;
- (b) All land in the Bechuanaland Protectorate owned by the Rhodesia Railways, Limited (as successors to the Bechuanaland Railway Company), in terms of Proclamations No 25 of 1896 and No. 4 of 1898, with the exception of level crossings and those parts of railway stations to which members of the public ordinarily have access;
- (c) Gaberones Crown Reserve.
