No. 18 of 1939.

It is hereby notified for general information that under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *seven* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Public Service Proclamation, 1924 (No. 32 of 1924), His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to make the following amendments in the Regulations published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 145 of 1925 as amended by High Commissioner's Notice No. 21 of 1931.

1. Regulation 5 of Chapter III of the Regulations is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following words:—

“Such occasional leave, or any part thereof, may be granted in conjunction with vacation leave when taken locally: Provided that such combined leave shall not exceed a period of six weeks in any year.”

2. Regulation 8 (1) of Chapter III of the Regulations as amended by High Commissioner's Notice No. 94 of 1938 is hereby further amended by deleting the words—

“In the case of officers who have completed two or more years' consecutive resident service spending their leave in some place overseas, the time necessarily taken—”

and substituting therefor the words—

“In the case of officers who have completed at least two years' resident service (reckoned from the date of first arrival in the Territory or from the date of return from overseas leave, as the case may be) spending their leave in some place overseas, the time necessarily taken—”.
