HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE

No. 228 OF 1939.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *two* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Prisons Proclamation, 1939 (No. 10 of 1939), His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to cancel Regulation 103 of the Regulations published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 45 of 1939 and to substitute the following Regulation therefor:—

“ 103. Hard labour gangs shall leave the prison for labour daily (weather permitting) in summer at 6 a.m. and in winter at 7.15 a.m., and shall return for the night in summer at 6 p.m. and in winter at 5 p.m. One hour shall be allowed at 8 a.m. and at 1 p.m. in winter, and one hour at 8 a.m. and two hours at 1 p.m. in summer, for food and rest.”
