HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE
No. 35 of 1939.

CUSTOMS.

ORDINARY DUMPING DUTY ON RUBBER
PNEUMATIC TYRES AND TUBES FROM
THE UNITED KINGDOM.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers in him vested by section *fifteen* of the Customs Tariff and Excise Duties Amendment Proclamation, 1925, as amended, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to declare that, from and after the tenth day of February, 1939, there shall be charged, levied, collected and paid on rubber pneumatic tyres and tubes on importation into the Bechuanaland Protectorate from the United Kingdom, an "ordinary" dumping duty equal to the difference between the export price as defined in section *nineteen* of the Customs Tariff and Excise Duties Amendment Proclamation, 1925, as amended, and the domestic value as defined in that section plus the extra cost of packing and packages for export, carriage to the port of shipment and all other expense incidental to placing the goods on board ship ready for exportation to the Bechuanaland Protectorate, Provided that—

- (a) such dumping duty shall be reduced by an amount computed on the weight of such tyres and tubes at 4d. per lb.
- (b) such dumping duty shall not exceed one-half of the value of the goods for duty purposes as defined in section *fourteen* of the said Proclamation, and
- (c) such dumping duty shall not be imposed in respect of such goods shipped to the Bechuanaland Protectorate from the United Kingdom prior to the above-mentioned date.
