

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE
No. 64 of 1939.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the provisions of section *four* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Game Proclamation, 1925 (No. 17 of 1925), His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to exclude from the Third Schedule to the aforesaid Proclamation all animals named therein for a period of twelve months from the date of publication of this Notice, within an area ten miles wide on either side of the motor road from a point twenty-eight miles north-east of Maun and running in a south-westerly direction through Maun to Toten and thence in a north-easterly direction to a point opposite Rantsadi; from this point the area extends ten miles to the west of the motor road as far as Gomare and includes the ground lying between the said road and the Taoghe River.
