HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE

CUSTOMS.

WITHDRAWAL OF DUMPING DUTY ON IRON
AND STEEL PLATES FROM THE UNITED
STATES OF AMERICA.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers in him vested by sub-section (2) of section *twelve* of the Customs Tariff and Excise Duties Amendment Proclamation, 1925, as amended, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to declare that High Commissioner's Notice No. 175 of 1938 is amended, with effect from the 5th May, 1939, by the deletion of the under-mentioned item:—

“(b) plates within the following dimensions, including non-rectangular plates, if the smallest rectangle from which they can be cut falls within the said dimensions—

- (i) plates from 12 inches to 18 inches inclusive in width and $\frac{1}{8}$ inch and over in thickness;
- (ii) plates over 18 inches wide which are $\frac{1}{8}$ inch and over but under $\frac{5}{16}$ inch in thickness.”
