

## BECHUANALAND PROCTETORATE.

No. 33 OF 1939.

(Promulgated 8th September, 1939.)

### PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER  
Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Income Tax  
Proclamation, 1939.

Whereas it is expedient to fix the rates of income tax and supertax to be levied in the Bechuanaland Protectorate in respect of the twelve months ended on the thirtieth day of June, 1939:

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested, I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. In terms of sub-section (3) of section <sup>Rates of</sup> *five* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Income Tax Proclamation, 1922, the rates of income tax to be levied in respect of the year ended on the thirtieth day of June, 1939, shall be the rates specified in paragraphs (a) and (b) of section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Income Tax Proclamation, 1932: <sup>income tax</sup> <sup>for</sup> <sup>1938-39.</sup>

Provided that the amounts arrived at by calculation in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (b) of section *one* abovementioned shall in the case of persons other than companies be subject to a rebate of twenty *per centum*.

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the <sup>Short title</sup> <sup>and com-</sup> <sup>men-</sup> Bechuanaland Protectorate Income Tax Proclamation, 1939, and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
