

# BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

No. 44 of 1939.

(Promulgated 22nd September, 1939.)

## PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER

Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Customs Tariff Amendment Proclamation, 1939.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the law relating to Customs in the Bechuanaland Protectorate, hereinafter referred to as "the Territory":

NOW THEREFORE I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. (1) Section *ten* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Customs Management Proclamation, 1914, is hereby amended—

(a) by the insertion at the end of paragraph (c) of the following proviso:

"Provided that if any printed, engraved, lithographic or photographic matter is according to the decision of the Resident Commissioner indecent, obscene or objectionable and is contained in any publication which from its own contents or in any other manner is proved to the satisfaction of the Resident Commissioner to be one of a series, the Resident Commissioner may, by Notice in two consecutive issues of the *Gazette*, publish the name of such publication, and every issue of that publication shall thereupon, and until such Notice is withdrawn by the Resident Commissioner, for the purposes of this section be deemed to be indecent, obscene or objectionable, as the case may be"; and by the insertion after paragraph (h) of the following paragraph:

(i) Second-hand coats, jerkins, jumpers, vests, trousers and cloaks intended for sale in the Territory".

(2) Paragraph (i) of the said section as amended by sub-section (1) shall not apply in respect of any article shipped to the Territory before the seventeenth day of June, 1939.

2. Section *twelve* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Customs Management Proclamation, 1914, is hereby amended by the addition at the end thereof of the following sub-section, the existing section becoming sub-section (1):

“(2) Any person who sells, offers or keeps for sale, or distributes or exhibits any issue of any publication in respect of which a Notice has been issued under paragraph (c) of section *ten*, and has not been withdrawn, shall be guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding fifty pounds or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding three months or to both such fine and imprisonment”.

Amendment of section 2 of Proclamation No. 20 of 1925, as amended by section 2 of Proclamation No. 43 of 1935.

3. (1) Section *two* of the Customs Tariff and Excise Duties Amendment Proclamation, 1925, as amended, (hereinafter referred to as “the principal law”), is hereby repealed and the following section is substituted therefor:

“2. (1) Subject to the provisions of this section and of all regulations made under this section, the goods described in Class XV. of the First Schedule to this Proclamation shall be admitted into the Territory under rebate of duty to the extent stated in the item of the said Class in which they are specified.

(2) Rebate of duty shall not be allowed under this section except in respect of goods entered for use only in the industry described in the item of Class XV. of the First Schedule in which those goods are specified.

(3) The High Commissioner may make regulations prescribing the conditions under which any goods shall be admitted under rebate of duty in terms of this section. Different regulations may be made in respect of different articles, substances, industries or areas.

(4) If goods in any consignment have been admitted under rebate of duty in terms of this section, all the goods in that consignment so admitted shall be liable to the full duty otherwise payable thereon under this Proclamation if any part thereof so admitted is used otherwise than in accordance with the conditions under or the purposes for which they were entered, or if the provisions of this section or any regulation applicable to them are not complied with”.

(2) Any regulation made or any condition prescribed or any other thing done under the provisions of section *two* of the principal law, as amended, shall be deemed to have been made,

prescribed or done under the provisions of that section as substituted by this section.

4. Section *nine* of the principal law is hereby amended—

(a) by the substitution for sub-section (1) of the following sub-section :

“(1) For the purposes of sections *one, five, six, seven* or *ten*, or for the purposes of any agreement of the nature referred to in the Customs (Trade Agreements) Proclamation, 1933, goods shall not be regarded as having been produced or manufactured in any particular state or country unless at least twenty-five per cent. of the factory or works costs of those goods is represented by material produced and labour performed in that state or country: Provided that where the Governor-General of the Union has, by agreement with the Government of any such state or country, increased the said percentage in regard to any particular class or kind of goods to which this sub-section applies when imported into the Union, the High Commissioner may apply to such particular class or kind of goods a similar increased percentage when imported into the Territory.”; and

(b) by the addition at the end thereof of the following sub-section :

“(3) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in this Chapter, any minimum or intermediate rate of duty which applies or has been applied under section *one, five, six, seven* or *ten* to any goods which, having been grown, produced or manufactured in a particular state or country, are imported from that state or country, shall apply also to such goods on importation from another state or country, if such minimum or intermediate rate of duty, as the case may be, applies to similar goods which, having been grown, produced or manufactured in such other state or country, are imported therefrom”.

5. Section *thirty-seven* of the principal law is hereby amended by the insertion in sub-section (2), after the word “regulations”, of the words “made under sub-section (3) of section *two* or sub-section (1) of section *twelve* or sub-section (1) of this section”.

6. The First and Second Schedules to the principal law, as amended, are hereby further amended in the manner shown respectively in the First and Second Schedules to this Proclamation.

7. This Proclamation may be cited as the Customs Tariff Amendment Proclamation, 1939, and shall be deemed to have had force and to have effect—

- (a) as regards any customs duties which are hereby imposed or increased, as from the eleventh day of May, 1939;
- (b) unless otherwise provided herein, as from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
