

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

GOVERNMENT NOTICE.

It is hereby notified for general information that in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section *six (a)* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Trading with the Enemy Proclamation, 1939 (No. 40 of 1939), as amended by the Bechuanaland Protectorate Trading with the Enemy (Amendment) Proclamation, 1940 (No. 27 of 1940), I do hereby make the following Order:—

1. Any moneys received by the Custodian of Enemy Property by virtue of any Order made or to be made by the Resident Commissioner under the above-named section may be invested by the Custodian in the purchase of Treasury Bills or such other British Government securities as the Resident Commissioner may from time to time specify.

2. The Bechuanaland Protectorate Trading with the Enemy (Custodian) Order, 1940, and every other such Order as aforesaid, shall be read and take effect as if it contained a provision authorising all moneys arising directly or indirectly to the Custodian under or by virtue of such Order to be dealt with in the manner authorised by this Order.

3. This Order may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Trading with the Enemy Investment Order, 1940.
