It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *seven* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Public Service Proclamation, 1924 (No. 32 of 1924), His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to make the following amendment in the Regulations published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 145 of 1925, as amended by High Commissioner's Notice No. 94 of 1938.

Chapter IV of the Regulations is hereby amended by inserting, immediately after Regulation 8, the following Regulation:—

“ 9. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this Chapter contained, any officer proceeding on leave overseas or to the coast under the provisions of this Chapter, may be granted free transport, up to an amount not exceeding the approved motor mileage rates, in respect of the journey (if any) from his station to the nearest rail-head, and may receive a similar grant in respect of the return journey to his station.”
