

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE  
No. 127 of 1940.

It is hereby notified for general information that under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to make the following amendments to the Bechuanaland Protectorate Defence (Finance) Regulations, 1939, as published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 235 of 1939:—

Regulation 6 of the said Regulations is hereby amended—

- (a) by the deletion in paragraph (1) of the words "which is in the Territory" in both places where they occur;
- (b) by the substitution in paragraph (2) for the word "balance" of the words "or of any balance";
- (c) by the addition at the end thereof of the following new paragraph:—

"(4) Where any goods of a value exceeding one hundred pounds are exported from the Territory on or after the tenth day of June, 1940, the person making entry of the goods shall, within fourteen days from the date on which entry has been made, furnish the Director of Customs with a declaration in the form of the Annexure hereto, duly completed and signed by the consignor or by a person duly authorised by him, and attested by an authorised dealer."
