BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE EXPORTATION AND IMPORTATION RESTRICTION PROCLAMATION, 1939.

CONTROL OF EXPORTS.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Exportation and Importation Restriction Proclamation, 1939 (No. 41 of 1939), His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to prohibit, as from the date of publication of this Notice in the *Gazette*, the exportation of any of the undermentioned articles from the Bechuanaland Protectorate to any country (other than the United Kingdom or Great Britain and Northern Ireland, or Eire, or any British Dominion or Colony or Possession of Mandated Territory, and other than a country to which no goods may, in terms of High Commissioner's Notice No. 16 of 1941, be exported without a permit) except with the permission in writing of the Resident Commissioner or an officer authorised by the Resident Commissioner to grant such permission.

Wattle bark and wattle extract.

Minerals and metals, including ores, concentrates and alloys, but excluding scrap metals.
