

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE

No. 102 OF 1941.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *two* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Prisons Proclamation, 1939 (No. 10 of 1939), His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to amend the Bechuanaland Protectorate Prison Regulations, published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 45 of 1939, by revoking paragraphs (1) and (2) of Regulation 153 and substituting therefor the following paragraphs:—

- “(1) Every prisoner who is sentenced to imprisonment, whether by one sentence or by consecutive sentences, for a period not exceeding one month shall, according to his conduct and industry and subject to these regulations, be allowed an ordinary or earned remission not exceeding one-third of his sentence.
- (2) Nothing in the preceding paragraph shall authorise the reduction of any period of imprisonment to be served to less than thirty days.”
