HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE  
No. 109 of 1941.

CUSTOMS: EXCHANGE DUMPING DUTIES.

It is hereby notified for general information that the High Commissioner has been pleased to approve of the following amendments to the Schedule to High Commissioner's Notice No. 21 of 1941:—

1. In item 15 (c) substitute the word "corn-flour" for the words "ground or otherwise prepared".
2. In item 41 substitute the letter and number "(a) (iii)" for the letter and number "(a) (ii)".
3. Add after the words "New Zealand" opposite item 65 (b) (vi) the word "Japan", with effect from 20th December, 1940.
4. In item 69 (e) and (f) delete the letter and word "(e) and" in both places.
5. Insert the following new item after item 260 (c) with effect from 20th December, 1940:—  
"263. Boxes falling under para- Japan."  
graph (b) of item 263 of  
the Customs Tariff
6. Delete the words "New Zealand" opposite item 307 (1), with effect from 20th December, 1940.
