HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers in him vested by section *thirty-nine* (1) of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Mines and Minerals Proclamation, 1932 (No. 33 of 1932), His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to declare the following area to be open for prospecting for or winning diamonds subject to the provisions of the said Proclamation, such declaration to take effect from the date of publication of this notice in the *Gazette*, on and after which date prospecting permits may be issued at the office of the Mining Commissioner at Lobatsi:—

That portion of the farm known as Ramathibama's Kuil situate in the Bechuanaland Protectorate and registered in the name of Arthur George Burton-Smith measuring 3,781 (three thousand seven hundred and eighty-one) morgen 142 (one hundred and forty-two) square rods.
