BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE EXPORTATION AND IMPORTATION RESTRICTION PROCLAMATION, 1939.

CONTROL OF IMPORTS (ALUMINIUM.)

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Exportation and Importation Restriction Proclamation, 1939 (No. 41 of 1939). His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to prohibit, as from the date of publication of this Notice in the *Gazette*, the importation into the Bechuanaland Protectorate of aluminium in the form of ingots, bars, pellets, strips, circles and extruded sections sheets and foil, except with the permission in writing of the Resident Commissioner or an officer authorised by the Resident Commissioner to grant such permission:

Provided that this prohibition shall not apply in connection with any such aluminium as aforesaid which has been despatched to the Bechuanaland Protectorate prior to the date of publication of this Notice in the *Gazette*.
