

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE

No. 130 of 1941.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Exportation and Importation Proclamation, 1939 (No. 41 of 1939), His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to prohibit, as from the date of the publication of this notice in the *Gazette*, the exportation from the Bechuanaland Protectorate of—

- (a) any exposed and undeveloped photographic film or plate to any country or territory except the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, the Union of South Africa, the Mandated Territory of South West Africa, Southern or Northern Rhodesia, Basutoland or Swaziland;
- (b) any exposed and undeveloped photographic film or plate to the said United Kingdom by other means than through the post;
- (c) any unexposed photographic film or plate to any country or territory except the said United Kingdom, the Union of South Africa, the Mandated Territory of South West Africa, Southern or Northern Rhodesia, Basutoland or Swaziland;
- (d) any developed photographic film or plate or any photograph, map, plan, sketch, drawing, print or other pictorial representation of any place or object of military or strategic importance in the Union of South Africa, the Mandated Territory of South West Africa, Southern or Northern Rhodesia, Basutoland, the Bechuanaland Protectorate or Swaziland, or any description of any such place or object, to any country or territory except the said United Kingdom, the Union of South Africa, the Mandated Territory of South West Africa, Southern or Northern Rhodesia, Basutoland or Swaziland, by other means than through the post;

except with the permission in writing of the Resident Commissioner or an officer authorised by the Resident Commissioner to grant such permission and subject to such conditions as may be set forth in such written permission.
