

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

**HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE
No. 189 of 1941.**

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *three* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Game Proclamation, 1940 (No. 19 of 1940), His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to make the amendments to the Second and Third Schedules to the said Proclamation in respect of the areas and species of game herein set out:—

Area.	Species of Game.	Amendment of Schedules.
Bakwena Reserve, as defined by section <i>four</i> of Proclamation No. 9 of 1899	Klipspringer (<i>Oreotragus oreotragus</i>)	Transferred from Third Schedule to Second Schedule.
Bamangwato Reserve, as defined by section <i>one</i> of Proclamation No. 9 of 1899, as amended by Proclamation No. 31 of 1933	Springbuck (<i>Antidorcas marsupialis</i>)	Transferred from Third Schedule to Second Schedule
Batawana Reserve, as defined by section <i>two</i> of Proclamation No. 9 of 1899	Springbuck (<i>Antidorcas marsupialis</i>)	Transferred from Third Schedule to Second Schedule.
In the Kgalagadi District, as defined in High Commissioner's Notice No. 119 of 1923 from a point where the Meridian 24° 15' East Longitude intersects the Molopo River north along the said Meridian for a distance of ten miles, thence in a Westerly direction parallel with the Molopo River and 10 miles from it to the intersection of this line with the 26th parallel of South Latitude, thence East along the said parallel to its intersection with the Molopo River and thence along that River back to the starting point	Blue Wildebeest (<i>Gorgon taurinus</i>)	Removed from the Second Schedule.
