**HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE**

**No. 196 of 1941.**

It is hereby notified for general information that, under the powers conferred upon him by subparagraphs (5) (1) (a) and (5) (2) (a) of Regulation 3 of Chapter I of the Public Service Regulations (printed in High Commissioner's Notice No. 149 of 1940), His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to prescribe the undermentioned examination subjects which must be passed by an Assistant Inspector of Police—

(a) for confirmation in his appointment as Assistant Inspector of Police, and

(b) for promotion to the post of Inspector of Police:

Native Tribunals Proclamation, No. 75 of 1934.

(ii) Police Proclamation, No. 69 of 1937, with the Regulations framed thereunder:

Police Standing Orders;

Standing Instructions, financial and accounting instructions.

- (iii) Criminal Procedure and Evidence Proclamation, No. 52 of 1938;
  - (iv) Drill, Musketry and care of arms;
  - (v) Animal and stable management;
  - (vi) Criminal Investigation.
- (b) *For promotion to the post of Inspector—*
