HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE

No. 21 OF 1941.

CUSTOMS: EXCHANGE DUMPING DUTIES.

It is hereby notified for general information that, in terms of sub-section (3) of section *fifteen* of the Customs Tariff and Excise Duties Amendment Proclamation, 1925, as amended, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to determine the rates at which the currencies of the under-mentioned countries shall be computed in terms of Bechuanaland Protectorate currency, for the purpose of assessing the lumping duty referred to in sub-section (4) of the above-mentioned section, to be as follows:—

Australia: £1 Australian = 19s. South African.

New Zealand: £1 New Zealand = 19s. South African.

Japan: 1 Yen = 23·35 pence South African,

and to notify that the goods to which such dumping duty shall apply shall after the 20th December, 1940, be as detailed in the appended schedule when such goods originate in, or are exported to the Bechuanaland Protectorate from, any of the countries shown opposite such goods in the said schedule.
