REGULATION.

The following Regulation, numbered 54A, is hereby inserted immediately after Regulation 54 of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Dairies and Dairy Produce Regulations published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 53 of 1941:—

“ 54A. No cream shall be exported from the Bechuanaland Protectorate except—

- (1) in such manner as shall be directed by the Resident Commissioner; and
- (2) unless accompanied by a permit issued by the Chief Agricultural Officer:

Provided that this prohibition shall not apply to cream consigned to the Union of South Africa, the Mandated Territory of South West Africa, Basutoland or Swaziland.”
