BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

† HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE

No. 25 of 1941.

It is hereby notified for general information that in exercise of the powers conferred on him by subsection (1) of section *one* of the Dairies and Dairy Produce (Bechuanaland Protectorate) Proclamation, 1929 (No. 1 of 1929), as amended by Proclamation No. 35 of 1930, the Resident Commissioner with the approval of the High Commissioner has imposed the following levies, with effect from the first day of January, 1941:—

- (a) in the case of creamery butter, at the rate of thirty-one-sixtieths of one penny per pound;
- (b) in the case of factory cheese, at the rate of one-tenth of one penny per pound; and
- (c) in the case of farm dairy butter and farm cheese, at the rate of one penny per pound.

2. Regulation (4) (1) of the Dairies and Dairy Produce Additional Regulations, published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 135 of 1930, is amended accordingly, and High Commissioner's Notice No. 221 of 1940 is hereby cancelled.
