HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE  
No. 42 of 1941.

It is hereby notified for general information that under the provisions of section *four* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Game Proclamation, 1940 (No. 19 of 1940), His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to declare the Bakgatla Reserve (as defined in section *three* of Proclamation No. 9 of 1899) to be an area within which the large and small game specified hereunder, shall be protected for a period of three years from the date of publication of this Notice.

LARGE GAME.

Ibis (family *Plegadidae*)—all species.  
Storks (family *Ciconiidae*)—all species.

SMALL GAME.

Wild Goose (family *Anatidae*)—three species—

1. Spur-winged Goose (*Plectropterus gambensis*).
2. Egyptian Goose (*Alopochen aegyptiacus*).
3. Dwarf Goose (*Nettion auritus*).

Wild Duck (family *Anatidae*)—all species.
