PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency THE HIGH COMMISSIONER

Entitled the Railway Accident Inquiry
(Bechuanaland Protectorate) (Amendment)
Proclamation, 1941.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Railway Accident Inquiry (Bechuanaland Protectorate) Proclamation, 1940, hereinafter referred to as "the principal law":

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *three* of the principal law is hereby amended by inserting immediately after the word "may" in the second line thereof, the words "subject to the High Commissioner's approval". Amendment of section 2 of Proclamation No. 9 of 1940.

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the Railway Accident Inquiry (Bechuanaland Protectorate) (Amendment) Proclamation, 1941, and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*. short title and commencement.
