PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER
Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Police
(Amendment) Proclamation, 1941.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Bechuanaland Protectorate Police Proclamation, 1937, hereinafter referred to as "the principal law";

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested, I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. (1) Sub-section (1) of section *four* of the principal law is hereby amended by inserting, immediately after the word "Protectorate", in the third line thereof, the words "within or without the Protectorate".

(2) The provisions of section *four* of the principal law, as amended by sub-section (1) of this section, shall extend to all persons who join the Force after the commencement of this Proclamation, and also to any persons serving in the Force at the commencement of this Proclamation who within six months after such commencement elect in writing to be subject to the provisions of section *four* of the principal law as so amended.

All members of the Force who shall not so elect as aforesaid shall remain subject to the terms of their engagement as defined before the commencement of this Proclamation.

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Police (Amendment) Proclamation, 1941, and shall have force and take effect as from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
