PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER
Entitled the Railway (Amendment) Proclamation,
1941.

Whereas it is expedient to make further provision in the Bechuanaland Protectorate for the appointment of an acting Chairman of the Railway Commission established under the Railway Proclamation, 1935, hereinafter referred to as "the principal law";

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in sub-section (4) of section *three* of the principal law it shall be lawful to appoint an acting Chairman of the Railway Commission established under the principal law during the absence on active service of the Chairman of the said Railway Commission:

Additional provision for appointment of acting chairman

Provided that no appointment of an acting Chairman shall be for a period exceeding six months at any one time.

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the Railway (Amendment) Proclamation, 1941, and shall be deemed to have had force and effect as from the first day of June, 1941.
