PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER.

Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) (Amendment) Proclamation, 1941.

Whereas it is expedient further to amend the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939, hereinafter referred to as "the principal law":

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *one* of the principal law, as amended by Proclamation No. 14 of 1940 and by Proclamation No. 51 of 1940, is hereby further amended by inserting, immediately after paragraph (d) of sub-section (2), the following additional paragraph:—

"(e) provide for safeguarding the interests of employees who volunteer and are accepted for military service."

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) (Amendment) Proclamation, 1941, and shall be deemed to have had force and effect as from the fourth day of September, 1939.
