PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER

Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Intoxicating
Liquors (Amendment) Proclamation, 1941.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Proclamation dated the 4th April, 1892, regulating the sale of intoxicating liquors, hereinafter referred to as "the principal law":

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *twenty-six* of the principal law is hereby amended by inserting, immediately after the word "Police" in the second line, the words "or Military".

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Intoxicating Liquors (Amendment) Proclamation, 1941, and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
