### PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER

Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Criminal Procedure and Evidence (Amendment) Proclamation, 1941.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Bechuanaland Protectorate Criminal Procedure and Evidence Proclamation, 1938, hereinafter referred to as "the principal law":

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *fifty* of the principal law is hereby amended as follows:—
  - (a) by deleting the words "policeman of the rank of Assistant Inspector" in the first line of sub-section (1) and substituting therefor the words "European policeman of the rank of Corporal";
  - (b) by deleting the word "Sergeant" in the second and fourth lines of sub-section (3) and substituting therefor the word "Corporal".

Amendment of section 50 of Proclamation No. 52 of 1938.

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Criminal Procedure and Evidence (Amendment) Proclamation, 1941, and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
