

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

RESIDENT COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No. 12 of 1941.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under the provisions of section *one* of Proclamation No. 40 of 1913, as amended by Proclamation No. 35 of 1916, I do hereby order that all shops within a radius of one mile from the Post Office at Palapye, in the Ngwato District, shall close—

- (a) at 1 p.m. for the rest of the day on Saturdays;
- (b) on all business days except Saturdays between the hours of 8 a.m. and 9 a.m. for the breakfast recess; from the 1st April to the 30th September, between the hours of 1 p.m. and 2.30 p.m. and from the 1st October to the 31st March between the hours of 1 p.m. and 3 p.m. for the midday recess;
- (c) on all business days from the 1st April to the 30th September from 5 p.m. to 7 a.m. on the following morning and from the 1st October to the 31st March from 5 p.m. to 6.30 a.m. the following morning.

This Order to take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
