RESIDENT COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No. 18 of 1941.

PREVENTION OF THE SPREAD OF SLEEPING
SICKNESS.

Under the powers in me vested by section *nine* (1) (j) of Proclamation No. 28 of 1939, as amended, I do hereby order that all persons using vehicular transport along the Maun-Toteng-Mohembo and Maun-Kazungula-Livingstone Roads, within the Sleeping Sickness areas as defined in High Commissioner's Notice No. 68 of 1940, are directed to submit their vehicles to disinfestation at all smudge huts along the said routes, and I do further order that no person shall use on the said routes any vehicle which together with its loads exceeds 9 ft. in height and 9 ft. in width except under authority of a written permit granted by the District Commissioner, Maun, or the Police Officers at Kasane, Kachikau or Tsau.

2. Resident Commissioner's Notice No. 10 of 1941 is hereby cancelled.
