

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE
No. 1 of 1942.

It is hereby notified for general information that, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section *forty-one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Native Labour Proclamation, 1941 (No. 56 of 1941) (hereinafter referred to as "the Proclamation"), the Resident Commissioner, with the approval of the High Commissioner, has made the following Regulations:—

1. A labour agent's licence issued in terms of section *five* of the Proclamation shall be in the form set out in Schedule A hereto.
2. The requirements of sub-section (2) of section *thirteen* of the Proclamation will be met by the retention by the labour agent of copies of the contract referred to in section *twenty-three* of the Proclamation.
3. In terms of sub-section (3) of section *thirteen* of the Proclamation the maximum remuneration which may be received by a labour agent is £1. 4s. for each worker recruited.
4. The pass required in terms of sub-section (9) of section *twenty-three* of the Proclamation shall be in the form set out in Schedule B hereto.

These Regulations shall have force and take effect from the second day of January, 1942.
