My Lord,

I have the honour to refer to the Customs Agreement between the Bechuanaland Protectorate and Southern Rhodesia which was signed at Pretoria on the 5th October, 1937, and at Salisbury on the 4th November, 1937, and to inform Your Excellency that my Ministers agree to the following amendments to that Agreement:—

- (1) Article II to be amended by the insertion of the words, " pipe tobacco, cigars " after the words " cigarette tobacco " where they occur in paragraph (d).
- (2) Article III to be amended by the insertion of the words, " pipe tobacco, cigars " after the words " cigarette tobacco " wherever they occur in that Article.

This despatch and Your Excellency's reply in similar terms will be regarded as a variation of the Agreement, which shall take effect on the 29th May, 1942

Sir,

I have the honour to acknowledge the receipt of Your Excellency's despatch No. 8 of the 13th April regarding the Customs Agreement between the Bechuanaland Protectorate and Southern Rhodesia which was signed at Pretoria on the 5th October, 1937, and at Salisbury on the 4th November, 1937. I note that Your Ministers agree to the following amendments to that Agreement:—

- (1) Article II to be amended by the insertion of the words " pipe tobacco, cigars " after the words " cigarette tobacco " where they occur in paragraph (d).
- (2) Article III to be amended by the insertion of the words " pipe tobacco, cigars " after the words " cigarette tobacco " wherever they occur in that Article.

2. On behalf of the Bechuanaland Protectorate I agree to the foregoing amendments to that Agreement.

3. This despatch and Your Excellency's despatch under reference in similar terms will be regarded as a variation of the Agreement which shall take effect on the 29th May, 1942.
