CONTROL OF IMPORTS.

It is hereby notified for general information that under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Exportation and Importation Restriction Proclamation, 1939 (No. 41 of 1939), His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to amend High Commissioner's Notice No. 224 of 1941 as follows:—

- (a) By adding at the end of sub-paragraph (j) of the first paragraph, the words "but excluding over-issues and used magazines and periodicals imported in bulk"; and
- (b) by inserting, immediately after sub-paragraph (r) of the first paragraph, the following new sub-paragraph:—

" (rⁱ) used empty bottles landed from ships at ports in the Union of South Africa or the Mandated Territory of South West Africa "
