CONTROL OF EXPORTS.

It is hereby notified for general information that under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by

section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Exportation and Importation Restriction Proclamation, 1939 (No. 41 of 1939), His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to amend High Commissioner's Notice No. 237 of 1941, as amended by High Commissioner's Notices No. 13 of 1942 and No. 52 of 1942, dealing with the Control of Exports, by inserting the words "except onions and potatoes" after the word "vegetables" in sub-paragraph (e) of the first paragraph, and by adding after item (lxxix) in sub-paragraph (a) of the first paragraph the following new items:—

- (lxx) Fishing boats.
- (lxxi) All pig products.
- (lxxii) Honey.
- (lxxiii) Essential oils.
- (lxxiv) Waxes.
- (lxxv) Fats.
- (lxxvi) Glycerol.
- (lxxvii) Fuel oil.
- (lxxviii) Non-ferrous metals and products.
- (lxxix) Mineral turpentine.
- (lxxx) Foodstuffs, excluding fresh vegetables and fruit, excepting potatoes and onions.
- (lxxxi) Radios, radio equipment and spares.
