HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE
No. 116 of 1942.

CONTROL OF MACHINE TOOLS.

It is hereby notified for general information that under and by virtue of the powers vested in me by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to make the following regulations relating to the acquisition, manufacture and disposal of machine tools in Basutoland, the Bechuanaland Protectorate and Swaziland (each of which is hereinafter respectively referred to as "the Territory")

REGULATIONS

1. No person shall, as from the date of publication of this Notice in *the Gazette*, acquire or manufacture any of the undermentioned machine tools, equipment or attachments, hereinafter referred to as "machine tools", except upon the authority of and subject to the terms of a permit issued by the Controller:—

- (1) Lathes of all types.
- (2) Automatic bar or chucking lathes, single or multi-spindle
- (3) Turret and capstan or ram type turret lathes
- (4) Drilling machines.
- (5) Shaping machines.
- (6) Grinding, lapping and/or polishing machines.
- (7) Threading, and/or screwing machines.

- (8) Horizontal or vertical boring machines.
- (9) Planing machines.
- (10) Milling machines.
- (11) Slotting machines.
- (12) Cutting-off machines, including sawing and profile cutting.
- (13) Engraving machines.
- (14) Die-sinking and die-casting machines.
- (15) Projection machines; thread, length and diameter measuring machines; hardness testing machines; slip gauges.
- (16) Power operated woodworking machines.
- (17) All fixtures and attachments used with any of the machines (1) to (16) inclusive.
- (18) Presses, forging machines, welding machines, all types, drop stamps, brakes, plate and sheet working machines.
- (19) All 2, 3 or 4 jaw chucks, hand or air operated.
- (20) Self-opening die-heads and collapsing taps of all types.

2. No application for a permit in terms of regulation 1 will be considered unless made on Form M.T. 1 hereof. Such application must be endorsed by a person who will supply the machine tools.

3. No permit, in terms of regulation 1 hereof, will be necessary for the importation of machine tools into the Territory; but the importer shall advise the Controller of such importation immediately he has received advice of importation, or failing that within seven days of arrival of such machine tools at a port of entry.

4. All such applications and notifications shall be addressed to the Government.

5. No person shall, as from the date of publication of this Notice in the *Gazette*, dispose of any machine tools to any other person unless such other person delivers a permit issued in terms of regulation 1 hereof.

6. Notwithstanding anything contained in these regulations, the Controller may, in his discretion, grant exemption from the whole or any of the provisions of these regulations.

7. Any person who contravenes any prohibition hereby imposed or who knowingly furnishes any incorrect or incomplete information shall be guilty of an offense and liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding two hundred pounds or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding one year, or to both such fine and imprisonment.
